Fees & Dues Schedule

Effective Nov 1, 2012

1. - Initiation Fee

The initiation fee shall be **\$100.00** payable when a new member application is filed with the membership chairperson. This fee shall be returned if the application is not accepted.

2. - Dues

The membership dues period is defined as that twelve month period ending each October 31st. Membership dues shall be in accordance with the following dues schedule:

- A. - Active member** (one person) **\$80.00 per year**
- B. - Family membership** (Active plus qualified Associate member(s)) **\$100.00 per year**
- C. - Prorated Dues:** (new members) **Nov. 1 – Apr. 30 100%** **May 1 – Oct. 31 50%**

Membership dues become due November 1st. Members whose dues fall in arrears beyond November 1st shall automatically lose membership. Reinstatement to active membership shall require payment of delinquent dues and fees. Reinstated members are not eligible for the new member dues prorating. Loss of membership in excess of one year requires an reapplication for new membership. A new member shall pay dues according to the prorated schedule for the balance of the current dues period, beginning when membership is accepted.

Honorary Members are exempt from initiation fees and dues.

3. - Assessed Fees

- A. – Summer Work Absence** **\$100**
- B. – Dues late fee (after Nov 1)** **\$20**
- C. – Lost key replacement** **\$5**
- D. – Returned check** **\$25 or bank fee** (the greater)

4. - Lodging Fees (per night)

A. – Winter (Ski season as declared by the Lodge Committee)

Adult member	\$25	Minor member (<21 yr)	Free if with Parent
Adult guest	\$35	Child guest (<21 yr)	\$20

B. - Summer

Adult member	\$10	Child member (<21 yr)	Free if with Parent
Adult guest	\$15	Child guest (<21 yr)	\$6

C. – Work (Performing scheduled work *at the lodge*)

No charge for a day of work and a day of play

5. - Club Badges

Club badges in excess of those issued to club members or distributed to non-members as part of a club activity promotion, are available at a cost of \$5.00 each.
